Crime Report Officer Ramos and Lieutenant Minoni-addressed complaints of "drag racing" along 347, speeding on Canal Road, quad and motorcycle nuisance. Suffolk County Police Department does not have decibel meters to measure loud muffler noise and are not able to pursue speeding vehicles. Residents expressed concerns about vagrancy and pan handling in our hamlet. Officers have tried to enforce the laws available to them. Friends of the Greenway and Corresponding Secretary Charles McAteer thanked Suffolk County P. D. for the swift response and eradication of hate graffiti along the Greenway. Residents very concerned about safety near the 7-11 and former Teachers Federal Bank on 112. We are asking Staller to secure the vacant bank.

Debbie Engelhardt Director of the Comsewogue Library encouraged residents to take advantage of the many programs available to them as listed in the newsletter and online.

Discussion of the Lawrence Aviation Site-Land Bank/Open Space/Passive Solar/LIRR train yard relocation.

We thanked Councilperson Jonathan Kornreich for all the progress at Train Car Park including a stage and fencing, walkway and a new sign. Shakespeare in the Park Wednesday July 27, 2022 from 6-9 pm.

Jonathan Kornreich presented a proposed redistricting of the Town of Brookhaven that would include dividing our hamlet between Council District 1 and Council District 2. The proposed maps were being reviewed by a redistricting committee. As the map was presented our members were opposed. Members were given a list of public hearings-August 2, 2022 at the Rose Carappa Center Mt. Sinai at 6 pm and August 3, 2022 Brookhaven Town Hall at 6 pm. NYS Assemblyman Steven Englebright offered information on the redistricting proposal.
